WILKES-BARRE/SCRANTON PENGUINS STAFF

KIRK MACDONALD – HEAD COACH

Kirk MacDonald returns for his third season as head coach of the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton Penguins. He was hired as the 12th head coach in team history on July 16, 2024, and proceeded to lead the club to its first 40-win season (40-24-7-1) since 2017-18. As an encore, he coached the Penguins to their fourth-best record in franchise history (46-17-7-2) and shepherded them to the Eastern Conference Final.

MacDonald, 42, has spent 13 seasons as a coach after wrapping up a six-year professional playing career. His first coaching job was at his alma mater, Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, as an assistant coach in 2013-14. He quickly transitioned to the Reading Royals of the ECHL, serving as an assistant coach for three seasons before being promoted to head coach and director of hockey operations four seasons. In his fourth and final season as Royals head coach (2021-22), the team went 45-17-7-2 and tied the franchise record with 99 points in a single season. Overall with Reading, MacDonald's squads went 155-86-25-9 (.625).

MacDonald, who hails from Victoria, British Columbia, then became the head coach of Dubuque Fighting Saints in the United States Hockey League for 2022-23 and 2023-24. In the latter campaign, MacDonald led Dubuque to the best record in the USHL's Eastern Conference, going 41-13-8 in the regular season before capturing the Eastern Conference Championship and making the Clark Cup Final. A forward in his playing days, MacDonald attended R.P.I. from 2002-07. However, his collegiate career stalled when he was diagnosed with testicular cancer in April of 2005. After a grueling recovery that required several surgeries and chemotherapy treatments, he returned to captain the Engineers for his senior year. During that 2006-07 season, he ultimately led the team in goals (12) and points (27). As a pro, he logged 272 AHL games with the Albany River Rats, Providence Bruins, Iowa Chops and Houston Aeros. MacDonald amassed 106 points (45G-61A) in that time. Furthermore, he appeared in 134 ECHL games for Reading and the Florida Everblades, picking up 111 points (51G-60A). He helped the Royals capture their first and only Kelly Cup in 2013, scoring the series-clinching goal in the Eastern Conference Final.

NICK LUUKKO – ASSISTANT COACH

Luukko, 34, returns to the Penguins for his third season, standing alongside a long-time ally in Kirk MacDonald. A sixth-round draft pick by the Philadelphia Flyers in 2010, MacDonald was on the bench as an assistant when Luukko embarked on his first pro season with the Reading Royals in 2015-16. After a four-year pro career, Luukko joined a now-head coach MacDonald's staff as an assistant for the Royals in 2019-20.

The West Chester, Pennsylvania native spent the past three seasons as the head coach and director of hockey operations for the Jacksonville Icemen of the ECHL. In those three seasons, the Icemen went 126-73-17 (.623). Luukko shepherded his team to a 44-win season in 2022-23, establishing a new club record.

In his four seasons of professional hockey, Luukko logged 274 ECHL games, all with Reading. The right-hand shot defenseman posted 25 goals and 62 assists for 87 points. He also appeared in seven career AHL games, all as a member of the Lehigh Valley Phantoms. Prior to turning pro, Luukko skated for four seasons at the University of Vermont, leading the team's blueliners in goals and points during his sophomore year. He also lifted the Clark Cup as USHL Champion with the Dubuque Fighting Saints in 2011.

BRAD MALONE – ASSISTANT COACH

Malone, 37, steps behind the bench for his second season with the Black and Gold. A veteran of a 13-season professional playing career, Malone turned his attention to coaching in 2024-25 with the OHL's Oshawa Generals. Malone started his maiden coaching voyage as the development coach of the Generals. However, Malone was promoted to interim head coach in December. Oshawa went 23-11-3-1 (.658) in the regular season and then made it to the OHL Final as Eastern Conference Champions.

The Miramichi, New Brunswick-born forward was drafted in the fourth round (105th overall) of the 2007 NHL Entry Draft by the Colorado Avalanche, then embarked on four years at the University of North Dakota. Throughout the course of his pro career, Malone logged 217 NHL games for the Avalanche, Carolina Hurricanes and Edmonton Oilers. He also suited up for 552 AHL games for the Lake Erie Monsters, Hershey Bears, Chicago Wolves and Bakersfield Condors. Each of his last seven AHL seasons came as a member of the Condors, where he served as captain for four years (2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23, 2023-24).

Brad is also a member of the famous Malone family. His uncle, Greg Malone, played 11 seasons in the NHL during the 1970's and 80's, predominantly for the Pittsburgh Penguins (495 games). Greg also served as Pittsburgh's Director of Scouting from 1989-2007. His cousin, Ryan Malone, also played for Pittsburgh, and ended up having a 647-game NHL career with the Penguins, Tampa Bay Lightning and New York Rangers. Ryan also skated for Team USA at the 2010 Winter Olympic Games. Another cousin, Mark Malone, briefly played pro hockey including 19 games with the Wheeling Nailers in 2006-07. His father, Jim Malone, also played in the AHL. A first-round draft pick (14th overall) by the Rangers in 1980, Jim dressed in 10 games for the Moncton Alpines in 1982-83 and 10 games for the Fredericton Express in 1984-85.

- ▼ Is the ECHL's all-time playoff wins leader with 73. His 20 career regular-season shutouts are tied for 3rd in league history, as well.
- ▼ Back-to-back Nick Vitucci Award winner as ECHL Goaltender of the Year for the 2024-2025 and 2025-2026 seasons. Also posted the best goals against average in the league in both 2023-24 (2.21), 2024-25 (1.92) and 2025-26 (1.84).

- ▼ Led the ECHL with his .929 save percentage in 2025-26, and placed 3rd overall in goals against average (2.09).
- ▼ Became the first goalie in Nailers history to win the Nick Vitucci Goaltender of the Year Award after leading the ECHL in save percentage (.923), tying for 1st in shutouts (4) and placing 2nd in goals against average (2.23).
- ▼ Topped the entire WHL with a .928 save percentage in 2021-22, while his 2.34 goals against average and 31 wins both ranked 4th.
- ▼ Established a Portland franchise-record shutout streak of 25:11 during February 2022, falling 14:02 shy of tying the WHL all-time record.
- ▼ Led WHL goaltenders with 2870 minutes played during the 2019-20 campaign.
- ▼ Owns three of the Top 5 spots for single-season save percentage in Prince George franchise history; 2020-21 (.915, 5th), 2019-20 (.917, 2nd) and 2021-22 (.923, 1st).
- ▼ Won gold with Canada at the 2018 Hlinka-Gretzky Cup, posting a 1.11 goals against average and .943 save percentage in two games.
